Description of JCIEA for employers

The academy includes about 50 hours of training plus group work in small groups during four long days together with around 100 delegates and 20 trainers from around Europe. Before the arrival the delegate fills in an online form and will receive a comprehensive Insights™ personality profile. The profile will be reflected on during the training modules.

When the delegate arrives back home from JCI European Academy, he/she has learned new tools on acting in and leading a group, how to take into better consideration and motivate the others, built an international network of like-minded people and future colleagues, learned how to act strategically towards United Nations Sustainable Development Goals – all this in communicating in English for four days in a row.

The course modules include:

- Improve communication skills in a multicultural environment
- Discover personality types and analyze the participant's strengths and improvement areas
- Complete group challenges with problem solving and team coordination
- Apply the parliamentary procedure during a general assembly
- Distinguish and experiment the group development phases
- Demonstrate and develop presentation technics during a group project delivery
- Develop leadership skills, arguing and convincing skills
- Deepen strategic thinking within the Sustainable Development Goals
- Learn from experience and take the lessons to plan the participant's future and impact their community

Delegates' eligibility

- Incoming Local Presidents (LP) or candidates for the election of LP
- Proficiency in English as the whole program is held in English
- In JCI > 2 years. Willing to serve JCI > 3 years
- Preferred < 35 years old
- Strongly advised to have graduated from JCI Impact and JCI Achieve

Each European JCI National Organization can nominate guaranteed 3 candidates and prioritize reserves;

JCI National Organizations with more than 1.500 members can nominate 5 candidates.

The maximum number of delegates per National Organization is 8!
